The purpose of giving awards to students at Cielo Vista School is to recognize student effort and achievement. Our mission is for every child to be successful in some way every day.

NINE WEEKS AWARDS

HONOR ROLL & OUTSTANDING STUDENT AWARDS

Incentives for Honor Roll & Outstanding Student awards will be given at the end of each grading period.

Grades PPCD-1

Outstanding Student Award Criteria of this award will be determined by academics and social development. Students in PPCD, PreK and Kinder must have all M's in academics and 3's in social development including PE and no discipline referrals. Students in 1st grade must have all M's in academics and 4's in social development including PE and no discipline referrals.

Satisfactory Student Award Criteria of this award will be determined by academics and social development. Students in PPCD, PreK and Kinder must have M's/P's in academics and 3's/2's in social development including PE and no discipline referrals. Students in 1st grade must have M's/P's in academics and 3's/4's in social development including PE and no discipline referrals.

Grades 2-5

A HONOR ROLL Students must have all A's in all subject areas including P.E. and all O's or S's in Effort, Behavior, or Character Development and no discipline referrals.

A-B HONOR ROLL Students must have all A's and B's in all subject areas including P.E. and all O's or S's in Effort, Behavior, or Character Development and no discipline referrals.

B HONOR ROLL Students must have all B's in all subject areas including P.E. and all O's or S's in Effort, Behavior, or Character Development and no discipline referrals.

BUG Award (Bringing Up Grades)

Students who have demonstrated great effort and shown improvement in student learning and behavioral responsibilities will be recognized.

A/R (Accelerated Reader) At the end of each 9 weeks, students who have met their AR goal, will receive a small reward.

TERRIFIC KID

Every student will be recognized as Student of the Month and a Terrific Kid at some point during the year. Students will receive a pencil, a Five Dollar CV, and their picture will be on display on the Bulletin Board. (Photo release permission has been approved by parents/guardian.)

ATTENDANCE

Students who have not been absent and who have three or fewer tardies to include taken out of school early per nine week grading period will receive a "Perfect Attendance" ribbon and a 10 CV dollars.

*Any student who accumulates more than 12 tardies (excused or unexcused) to include taken out of school early per school year, will **not** be eligible to receive "perfect attendance" recognition **for the year**.

GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

Every nine weeks PE Coaches will select two students per class to receive the Good Sportsmanship Award. Recipients of these awards are at PE Coaches discretion. Students will receive 10 CV dollars and a pencil.

CV VALUE EXCHANGE AT THE CV STORE

The CV's are designed to help motivate the students at Cielo Vista. CV's may be obtained through the office. Because the CV's are like money, lost CV's cannot be replaced.

1 CV Value:

Twenty-five One Dollar CV's will be given to teachers in grades 3-5 each nine weeks to be used as a reward/incentive at the teacher's discretion. Fifty One Dollar CV's will be given to teachers in grades PreK - 2nd grade to be used as a reward/incentive at the teacher's discretion.

5 CV Value:

A/B Honor Roll with all O's and S's (2nd-5th)

Outstanding Student Award with no 1's (PPCD-1st)
Reward for participation in Service Projects (Hall Patrol, Recycling etc.)

Perfect Attendance (PreK - 5th)

END OF YEAR AWARDS

Orchestra Awards (5th grade) - Students from Orchestra class will be selected by the Orchestra teacher on their basis of mastery in the instrument currently used and on who has shown improvement and made great effort.

AR (Accelerated Reader) Students who have met their AR goal for one 9-week period will receive an Associate's Degree Certificate.

Students who have met their AR goal for two 9-week periods will receive a Bachelor's Degree Certificate.

Students who have met their AR goal for three 9-week periods will receive a Master's Degree Certificate.

Students who have met their AR goal for four 9-week periods will receive a Doctoral Degree Certificate.

Humanitarian Award - for 5th grade . All participants will receive a medal. One student will be selected with a grand prize award. Participants will be judged by a committee on the basis of the quality and service of their volunteer work.

Outstanding Achievement Certificate (Kinder & 1st) Student must achieve M's and 3's in Kinder and M's and 4's in 1st grade in the subject area for the entire year

Outstanding Achievement Certificate (2nd - 5th) Students must achieve 95% or above each nine weeks for the entire year in the subject area.

Most Improved Certificates Students in PPCD - 5th grades may receive a "Most Improved" ribbon at the end of the year for an area of improvement decided upon by the teacher.

Service Awards Students who volunteer for activities which are of service to others (e.g. Hall Patrol, Student Council) will receive this award.

Citizenship Trophy This award will be given at the discretion of the teacher. Two awards may be given per home room (PreK - 5). The student must not have any I's, N's or U's, have a positive attitude, be a productive citizen, and participate in school activities consistently throughout the year.

Excellent Attendance Certificate - Students with 2 or fewer absences.

Any student who accumulates more than 12 tardies (excused or unexcused) to include taken out of school early per school year, will **not** be eligible to receive "perfect attendance" recognition for that grading period or **for the year**.

All A Honor Roll Medal - Students who receive all A's Honor Roll for the entire year will receive a medal. No discipline referrals.

Perfect Attendance Medal Students with zero absences.

Any student who accumulates more than 12 tardies (excused or unexcused) to include taken out of school early per school year, will not be eligible for the Perfect Attendance Medal.

For Pre-K students, the instructional day begins at 7:55 A.M. (morning class) and 11:30 A.M. (afternoon class).

For students in grades Kinder through Fifth, the instructional day begins at 8:15 A.M. **The tardy bell rings at 8:15 A.M. Contenders will be recognized at Award ceremonies but medal will be given the last day of school.**

Texas Bluebonnet Trophy Students from 3rd to 5th grade who read all 20 books nominated for the Texas Bluebonnet Award, will be eligible to receive a trophy.

Daughters of American Revolution Trophy One student from 5th grade is selected by the 5th grade teachers. This award is presented to a student who by their personal acts and attitudes has proven himself/herself the most outstanding citizen in the class.

Criteria for All Cielo Vista Boy & Girl (2) (fifth grade) These two students will receive a prize determined by the Cielo Vista Optimist Club.

1. Academics—Excellent grades
2. Citizenship—Good behavior and productive citizen
3. Service to school—Participates in school activities
4. Attitude—Positive and cooperative
5. Attendance—Excellent attendance
6. Consistent Positive Effort

Good Sportsmanship Medal One boy and one girl per grade level will be selected and will receive a medal
